Thank you for your interest in our **Principal Oboe** audition. Preliminary auditions will occur on November 10 and 11, 2013. Semifinal auditions are scheduled for November 12. The final auditions will take place on Monday, December 9, 2013 when the Audition Committee along with our music director, Leonard Slatkin, will hear the finalists.

Please note that this position is available for employment at the beginning of the 2014-2015 season. Finalists may be asked to play in the orchestra for up to two weeks before an offer of employment is made.

Following, please find an application for employment and an audition repertoire list. **An audition deposit of \$100.00 (in US funds) is required from all candidates. All materials:** the application, résumé, and audition deposit must be <u>postmarked</u> no later than Monday, September 23, 2013 in order to participate in the audition. Checks should be made payable to Detroit Symphony Orchestra. This deposit will be refunded upon arrival for the audition. If a specific day or time is required for your audition please indicate the needs <u>and</u> reasons when you submit your paperwork. It is not always possible to fulfill requests; however, chances are greater the sooner the request is submitted. Please do not wait until after an audition time has been assigned to request a specific date or time. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

In the event that you should need to cancel, you must contact me via email (audition@dso.org), or phone (313-576-5497) **no later than Tuesday, October 22, 2013** otherwise we will be unable to refund your deposit. We respectfully ask that you submit an application form only if you are serious about attending the audition.

Upon receiving your application, résumé, and deposit all subsequent correspondence, including an audition time, will be sent via email. Additionally, please limit your résumé to one-page and remember to include your email address in your contact information.
